The Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation (HUPA) has announced the setting up of an inter-ministerial taskforce to study the impact of migration on housing, infrastructure and livelihoods in India. SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS (SDGs)

The 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda was adopted by world leaders at the UN Sustainable Development Summit (New York, 25-27 Sept) with 17 SDGs and 169 specific targets, aimed at ending poverty, reducing inequalities and protecting the environment.
