





10–23 July & 21 Aug – 3 Sept 2011 WHV – Wachau ♦ Wachau Cultural Landscape, Towns of Krems and Melk, Austria

The programme aimed to maintain and preserve natural and cultural landscape of the area, especially 8-9 hectares of dry grasslands in the forest. More than 10 hectares were preserved and a hiking trail was also reconstructed.

A press conference was organized to raise people's awareness on the importance of preserving our common heritage and environments, which helped the project to gain visibility. 4 Journalists, 1 TV-Station, 2 radio stations and 35 interested politicians and project partners participated. All in all, 17 articles were publicized in newspapers and online-journals.
