



Workshop objectives

- 1) Review recent national experiences and trends regarding ICT in education.
- 2) Advocate for the inclusion of ICT in education items into national schools census forms.
- 3) Review ICT in education policy-relevant indicators for both developed and developing country contexts.
- 4) Develop statistical capacity of national respondents from Ministries and National statistical offices (NSOs) to complete the UIS survey on ICT in education.

- 5) Increase the number of countries in the region that regularly produce quality ICT in education statistics.
- 6) To advocate the use of ICT in education indicators to support evidence-based policy making.
- 7) To share experiences with other countries in the field of ICT in education indicators, and to address the problems that countries may encounter in collecting ICT in education statistics.
- 8) To gain knowledge about the particular characteristics of ICT in education statistics data collection and use in the context of Central and Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia.
