

Practical information for participants of the High-level round table:

How to enhance policy support for Education for Sustainable Development?

- 1. The high-level round table will take place on Monday 10 November from 14.00 to 16.00 in the Shirotori Hall, Nagoya Congress Center.
- 2. Ministerial-level representatives of UNESCO Member States and heads of intergovernmental organizations and other high-level representatives are invited to join the discussion.
- 3. Space permitting, other conference participants will be able to follow the high-level round table in the room as observers. A live broadcast will also be available for conference participants. In addition, live and on-demand video streaming will be available on the conference website.
- 4. The round table will address the following four key questions:
 - Why has ESD been adopted by some countries but not by others?
 - What are the success factors that enable the integration of ESD into education and sustainable development policies?
 - What prevents the creation of an enabling policy environment for ESD?
 - What actions are needed at national and international levels in order to enhance the policy response to ESD?
- 5. The round table will be co-chaired by Irina Bokova, Director-General of UNESCO, and Hakubun Shimomura, Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Japan..
- 6. The round table will be moderated by Stephen Cole, Presenter for Al Jazeera English, Doha and London, and former presenter of the BBC World programme.
- 7. After the opening and the introductory statements, participants will be invited to make a two-minute intervention, responding to one of the **key questions**. Ministers will be given priority by the moderator.
- 8. The moderator will manage the list of speakers with the assistance of the Secretariat.
