THE ROCK ISLANDS DECLARATION

UNESCO SMALL ISLANDS VOICE KOROR-PELAU, NOVEMBER, 2002

WE, THE PARTICIPANTS AND REPRESENTATIVES OF THE PEOPLE OF OUR SMALL ISLANDS:

NOTE that as we embark upon the third millennium, critical issues regarding the environment and development present special challenges for us as Small Island Developing States;

FURTHER NOTE that positioning civil society to debate and broaden its decision-making capability requires openness and interaction to ensure the preservation of an excellent quality of life for generations to come;

RECOGNIZE

- that the needs and the wishes of small island developing states are similar;
- that the goals, desires and aspirations of our individual societies are common;
- that we profoundly respect each others miriad cultures and traditions;
- that there is a need to preserve and further enrich the cultures and traditions, and at the same time, advance in the global environment;

DECLARE

- that the UNESCO Small Islands Voice Project will not only strengthen the integration of Small Islands Developing states, but will also ensure continuous dialogue and debate on environmentals an developmental issues;
- that with a view to realizing these objectives, UNESCO's continued technical and financial assistance is critical;
- that our appreciation to UNESCO for the "Small Islands Voice" initiative is profound and unflinching;
- that our support for the ideals of the Organization remain strong;

URGE

- that UNESCO incorporates all additional phases of the Small Islands Voice Project in subsequent biennia;
- that as the catalyst of this project, UNESCO has the responsibility to ensure its sustainability for as long as this need is expressed by the participating islands and their peoples;
