- ALADIN community: ALADIN members and friends of ALADIN, e-mail Listserv (400 recipients)

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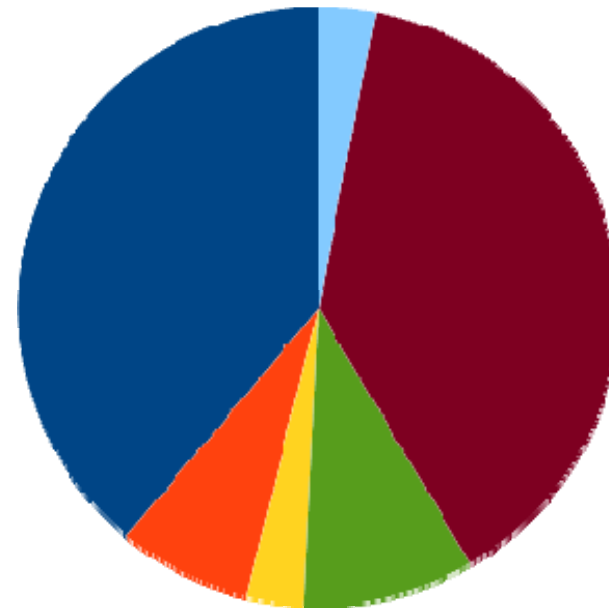

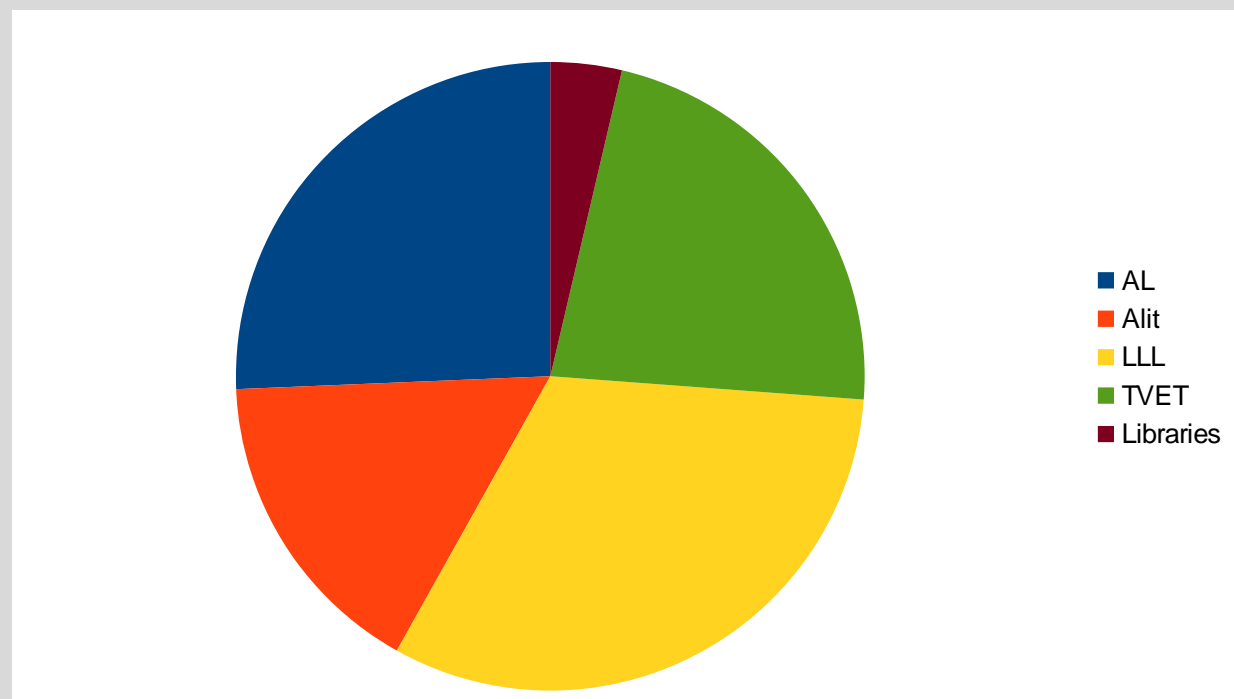

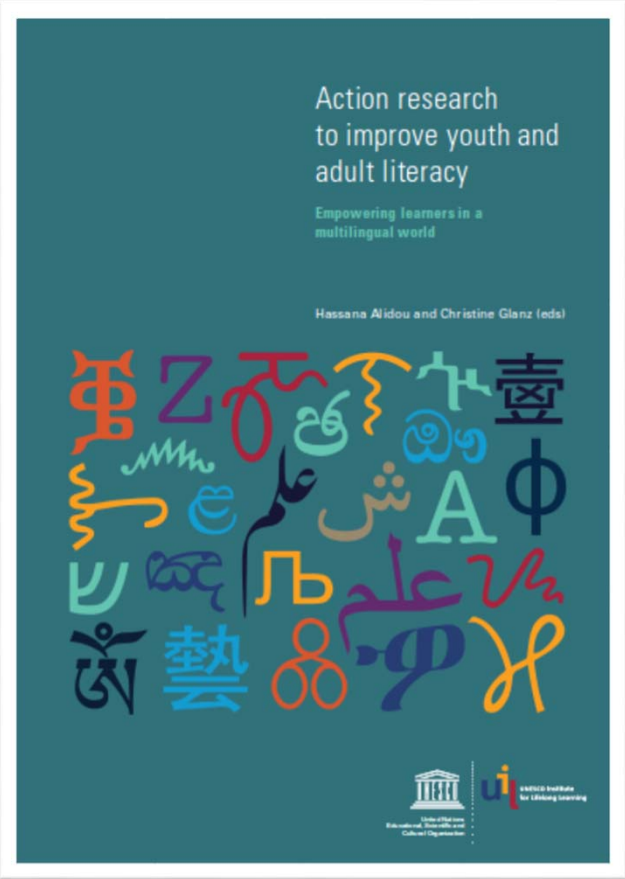
