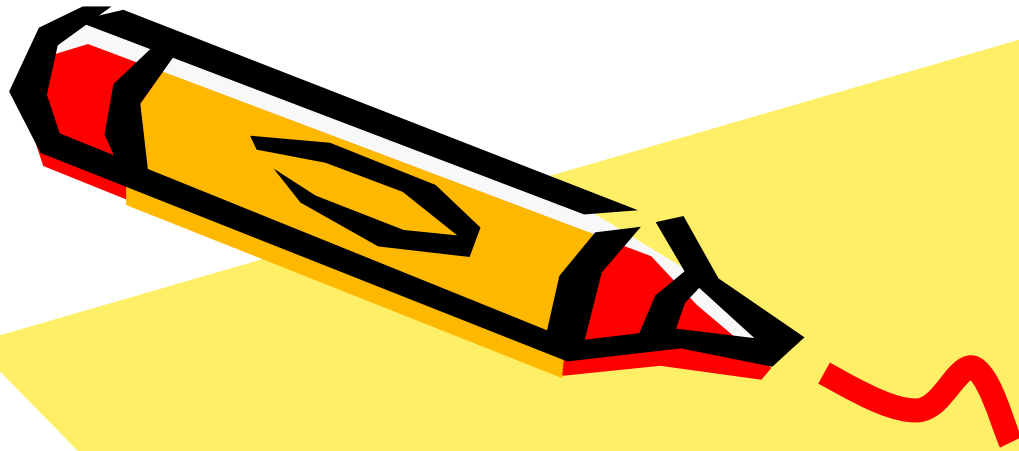

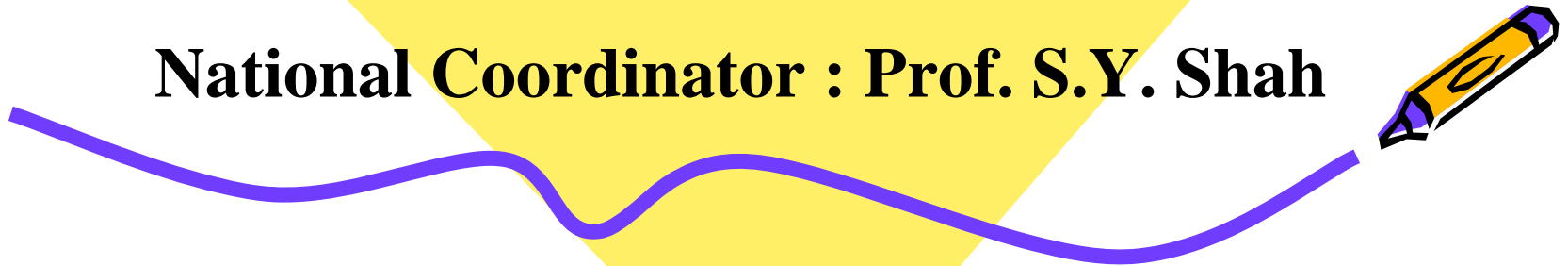

# PALDIN-3

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## **How did the idea emerge?**

- Idea of capacity building of adult educators has been highlighted in CONFINTEA, Belem Framework of Action and ASEM Network on Professionalization of Adult Education and several other forums.
- It is a mandate of ALADIN
- It was reiterated when UIL sponsored a Country Study on ALADIN in 2004.
- It was discussed and ratified in a National Workshop held in 2005 (Co-sponsored by UIL) in which 45 organizations participated.

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### **The need for a capacity building programme?**

- **Limitations of existing training programmes**
- **Inadequacy of Diploma/Certificate courses**
- **Limited availability of professional manpower**

# PALDIN-5

## ■ Why PALDIN?

- Indian study noted four different types of ALADIN organizations with four categories of personnel with a variety of job specifications not possessed by many.
- Small organizations with one or two staff had limited expertise and were greatly handicapped.
- The challenge was -how to equip the staff with all the requisite expertise through a comprehensive program of short duration.

- Large numbers & geographically scattered personnel.
- 200 potential ALADIN members.
- 600 District Adult Education Coordinators
- 200,000---300,000 Field Coordinators

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# PALDIN-9

## Main suggestions of stakeholders

- I. The majority preferred short duration program of 4-6 months.
  - II. Maximum study hours-two per day.
  - III. Mode of learning-75% preferred ODL format with a contact session in the beginning.
  - IV. Only 10% opted for E-learning;
  - V. Name of the course : *PARTICIPATORY ADULT LEARNING DOCUMENTATION AND INFORMATION NETWORKING (PALDIN)- Linking with UNESCOs ALADIN (ADULT LEARNING DOCUMENTATION AND INFORMATION NETWORK)*

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## **PALDIN: Programme Profile**

- **Target group:** Adult Educators (Program Managers, Researchers, Documentation Officers, Librarians, Lecturers working in ALADIN Member Institutions)
- **Eligibility:** Graduate
- **Medium of Instruction &:** English
- **Curriculum Transaction:** Personal Contact, Self-learning through print materials, Online/ Interactive CD support
- **Evaluation:** Participatory, group based, self evaluation (Diary/Journal Writing), Video Documentation
- **Delivery Agents:** ALADIN Member Institutions
- **Total Credits & Duration:** 12 ( 360 study hours ) – 4-6 months.

## OBJECTIVES:

1. *Provide learners with a conceptual understanding of the various roles of adult educators in the context of contemporary socio-economic life;*
2. *Help learners acquire relevant knowledge and skills—and sharpen existing ones—pertaining to adult learning, information and communication technologies, documentation, information management, dissemination and networking; and*
3. *Provide learners with opportunities to apply what they have learned in each unit so that they can reflect on their new learning and apply it in their day-to-day work situations.*

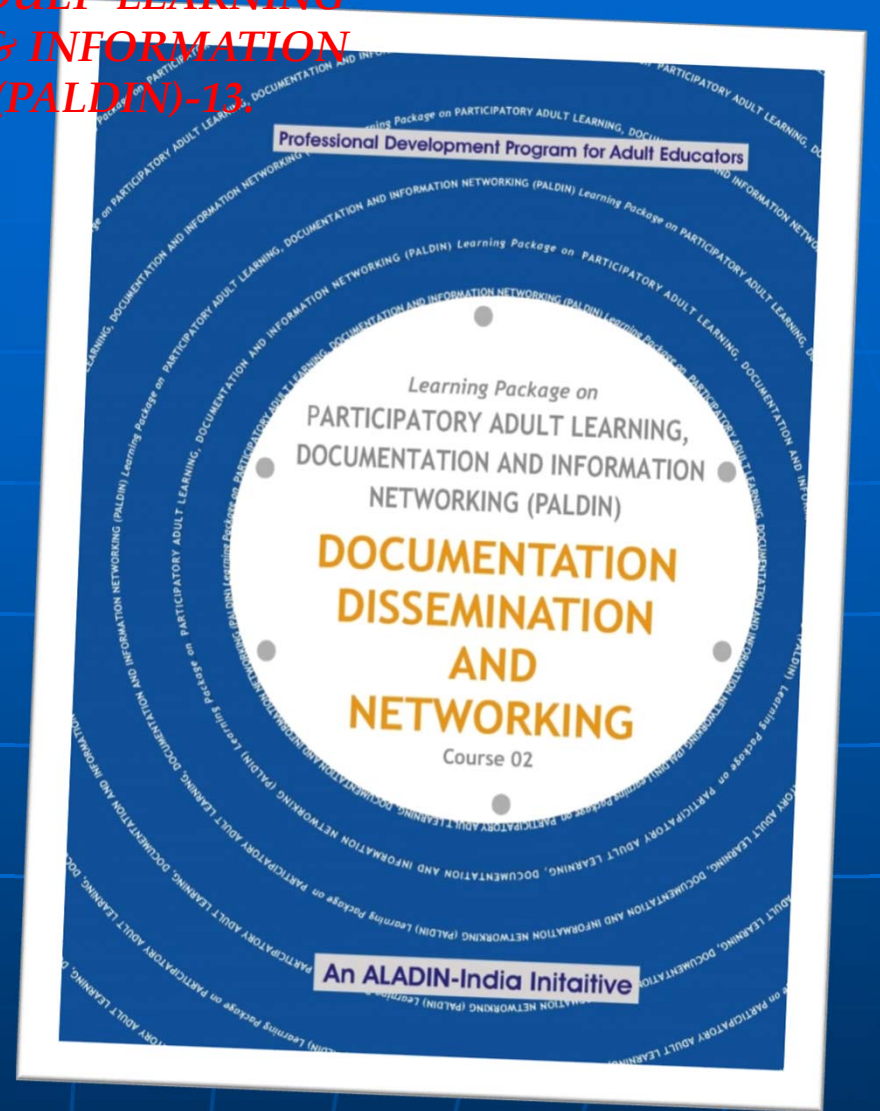
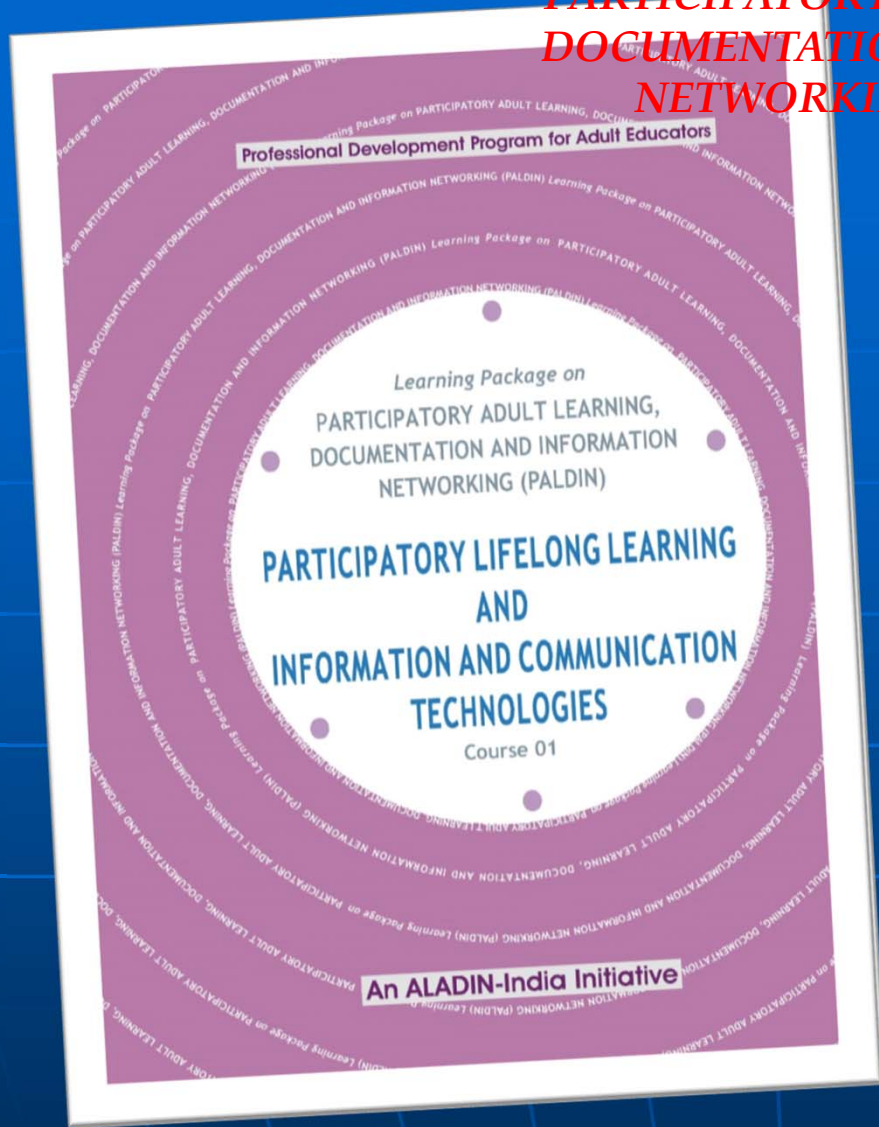

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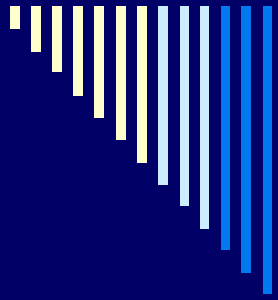
- **POST-GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN ADULT EDUCATION:**

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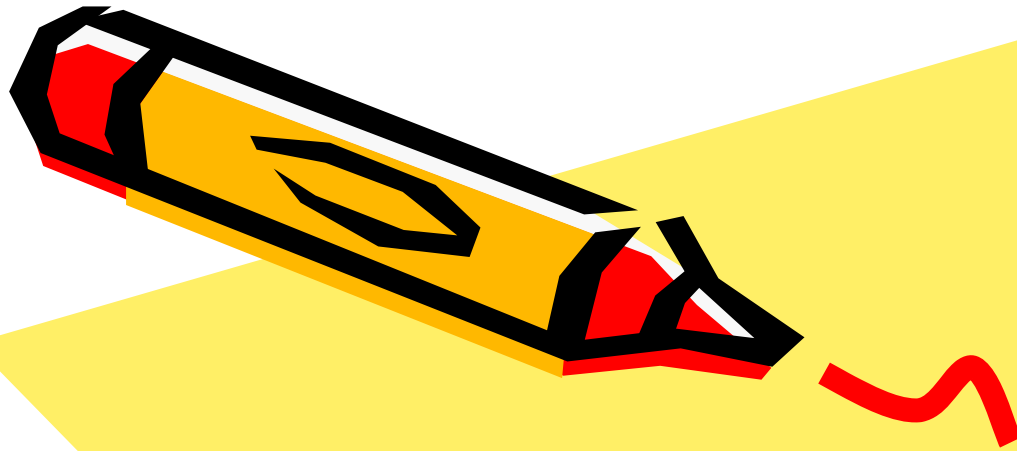

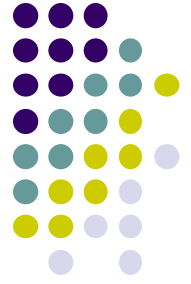
