Five Easy Ways to Use Mobile

- Informing: Targeted mobile alerts get information to youth at scale.
- Interacting: Two-way polling and data collection enhances M&E, empowers youth to share their views.
- Learning: Interactive content libraries let youth access pre-recorded information/educational materials via mobile audio.
- > Sharing: Mobile peer networks lets groups of youth send questions and get responses from peers/experts.






Mobile Alerts: Create Groups

SMS Alerts: Key Advantages

Advantages:

- Instant, large scale "one-to-many" communication.
- Send messages/manage target lists from web.
- Customized groups: Send specific information to specific youth.
- Flexible and scalable: Integrate with existing program components and database systems; scale up or down depending on need.

Alerts in Action:

- Reminders, eg. "Accounting training course starts today, at the youth center at 6 pm. Don't miss it!". (Jordan IYF/USAID)
- Calls to action, eg. "Listen to the latest radio program on local governance at 7 pm" (Sudan/South Sudan – EDC/State Dept)
- ➤ Program updates, eg. "as of today, 700 youth have finished basic skills training. Congrats!" (Gaza Mercy Corps)






ABOUT THIS PROJECT

Goal Tracking & Feedback: Key Advantages


Advantages:

- ➤ Real-time, dynamic communication between youth and project staff, at a national/regional scale.
- Widespread access: Works on any phone; no new hardware needed.
- Multi-purpose: youth track progress, project staff identify support needs

- Skills training evaluations (Morocco EFE/MasterCard)








Interactive Audio Library: Key Advantages


Advantages:

- Versatility: Easily combined with other program components and services (alerts/surveys).
- Accessible: Personalized instructional content for low-literacy youth. Can also be used to administer tests/polls.





SMS PeerNet: Key Advantages

Advantages:

- "Anytime, anywhere" ability to access an entire peer resource and support network
- High-impact: Sustains the work of cohort learning and trainings through a low-cost, long-term knowledge sharing mechanism
- Discreet: Enables marginalized/rural users to communicate in real time, without need for travel or in-person meetings

Technology in Action:

- Peer support network for training program alumni (12 countries State Dept)
- Peer support network for female community leaders (Iraq Mercy Corps/State Dept)
- Information network for female small business owners (West Bank/Gaza State Dept/MEPI)

Lessons Learned/Best Practices for Effective Mobile Tech Integration

- Customized software platform design: meets specific stakeholder needs, responds to core funder criteria.
- Targeted face-to-face training of platform managers (implementer staff); active engagement of "home office" and "field office".
- Direct partnerships with mobile networks: Robust network infrastructure, custom Sender IDs/shortcodes.
- Ongoing strategic advising for partners: Sharing 'lessons learned' across our entire portfolio.
- Frequent interaction with stakeholders; platform updates based on real-time feedback.
