FINANCIAL REPORT ON THE FUND FOR THE ELIMINATION OF DOPING IN SPORT

Summary

Document: Financial report of the Approval Committee of the Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport, financial statements for the period from 1 January 2014 to 31 July 2015 (Annex).

Context: This document presents the Financial Statements for the Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport. This information is provided in accordance with Resolution 1CP/7 of the Conference of Parties, which requested the annual preparation of an itemized, certified statement showing expenditure between priority areas of the Fund.

Decision required: Paragraph 4.

INTRODUCTION

- The Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport (hereinafter referred to as "the Fund"), as set forth in Article 17 of the International Convention against Doping in Sport (hereinafter referred to as "the Convention"), was established in February 2007. A Special Account was created for the administration of the Fund in accordance with Article 6, paragraph 5 of the Financial Regulations of UNESCO immediately following the entry into force of the Convention. The advantage of a Special Account is that multiple contributions can be combined to finance specific projects and funds can be carried over from one biennium to another with any interest accrued reinvested in accordance with Article 17 of the Convention. In accordance with the UNESCO Administrative Manual, a 10% programme support cost is applicable to this Special Account.
- Since its inception, the Fund has been well supported by the States Parties to the 2. Convention. A total of five States Parties have made contributions to the Fund in 2014-2015. Several of these five States made multiple contributions. As a result of these generous contributions and the interest accrued, the Fund remains in a strong financial position.
- Attached to this document are the annual financial statements for the Fund as prepared by the Bureau of Financial Management (BFM) for the period from 1 January 2014 to 31 July 2015 (see annex of this report). All income and expenditure as well as any changes in reserves or fund balances are presented as well as a breakdown of expenditure between the three priority areas of the Fund as approved by the Conference of Parties.² This is in accordance with Resolution 1CP/7, which, inter alia, requested the production on an annual basis of a detailed, certified statement showing expenditure between priority areas. The Report of the Approval Committee for the Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport, presented in a separate document [ICDS/5CP/Doc.6], provides a narrative report on the expenditure of the Fund and the results achieved.

- 3. Notes the financial status of the Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport and encourages the States Parties to make it possible to implement the projects submitted.
