ASEAN dynamic economic region

- Economic integration through ASEAN and free trade agreement with China
- Fast economic growth in the region with all partner countries at differing stages of development
- Continuous growing demand for qualified workers and growing mobility of work force
- In line with AFTA 2015 and processes of integration and harmonization







Reforming and harmonizing TVET-systems

- Vocational training in most countries does not meet the demand regarding practical vocational competences
- UNESCO initiative "reform review of TVET system" is welcomed
- Common regional standards for TVET must be set up as a common guideline
- Focus has to be set on the reform of vocational teacher education







RCP aims at Reform of VTE-Systems

- Seven universities from China, Thailand, Indonesia, Laos and Vietnam joined the Regional Co-operation Platform (RCP)
- Teachers function as multiplicators: "teachers teach the way they were taught!"
- We exchange best-practice, strengthen our research capacities and change our teaching methods
- We need to focus on TVET-teachers with a broad range of practical competences from the world of work
- In order to change the TVET-Systems we need teachers to act as "agents of change"







Approach to a reform policy of VTE

What is the correct solution for the lack of practical competences?

- Study programme at bachelor level addressing experts from the world of work
 - 1) extra-occupational
 - 2) blended-learning-concept
 - 3) recognition of prior learning experiences
 - 4) eased study admission
- Time frame before this program has an effect on the labour market is approximately 10 years
