ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE APPROVAL COMMITTEE FOR THE FUND FOR THE ÉLIMINATION OF DOPING IN SPORT

Decision required: paragraph 3.

1. The Approval Committee for the Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport (hereinafter referred to as “the Approval Committee”) was formally established by the Conference of Parties at its second session in October 2009. Resolutions 2CP/4.3 and 3CP/6.3 set forth the mandate of the Approval Committee; it is responsible for the allocation of the Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport in accordance with the resolutions of the Conference of Parties.

2. In accordance with Resolution 2CP/4.3, the Approval Committee shall consist of six representatives of States Parties elected by the Conference of Parties on the basis of equitable geographical representation (one from each of the electoral groups as established by the General Conference of UNESCO – see the annex hereto), who will serve until the next ordinary session of the Conference of Parties. Moreover, States Parties are encouraged to nominate representatives who have recognized experience and knowledge in the field of anti-doping.

3. The Conference of Parties may wish to adopt the following resolution:

The Conference of the Parties,
