## Financial Report on the Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport

#### **Summary**

**Documents:** Report of the Approval Committee for the Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport, Financial Statements for the years 1 January to 31 December 2010 (herewith attached as Annex I) and 1 January to 30 September 2011 (herewith attached as Annex II)

**Background:** This document presents the Financial Statements for the Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport. This information is provided in accordance with Resolution 1CP/7 of the Conference of Parties, which requested the annual preparation of an itemized certified statement showing expenditure between priority areas of the Fund.

#### INTRODUCTION

- 1. The Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport (hereinafter referred to as "the Fund"), as set forth in Article 17 of the International Convention against Doping in Sport (hereinafter referred to as "the Convention"), was established in February 2007. A special account was created for the administration of the Fund in accordance with Article 6, paragraph 6, of the Financial Regulations of UNESCO immediately following the entry into force of the Convention. The advantage of a special account is that multiple contributions can be combined to finance specific projects and funds can be carried over from one biennium to another with any interest accrued reinvested in accordance with Article 17 of the Convention. In accordance with Administrative Circular No. 2280, a 10% programme support cost is applicable to this special account.
- 2. Since its inception, the Fund has been well supported by States Parties to the Convention. A total of seven States Parties have made contributions to the Fund in 2010-2011.<sup>1</sup> Several of these states have made multiple contributions. As a result of these generous contributions and interest accrued, the Fund remains in a strong financial position.
- 3. Attached to this document are the annual financial statements for the Fund as prepared by the Bureau of Financial Management (BFM). These financial statements cover the calendar year 2010 (Annex I of this report) and the period from 1 January 2011 to 30 September 2011 (Annex II of this report). All income and expenditure as well as any changes in reserves or fund balances are presented as well as a breakdown of expenditure between the three priority areas of the Fund as approved by the Conference of Parties.<sup>2</sup> This is in accordance with Resolution 1CP/7, which, *inter alia*, requested the production on an annual basis of an itemized certified statement showing expenditure between priority areas. The Report of the Approval Committee for the Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport, presented in a separate document [ICDS/3CP/Doc.6 refers], provides a narrative report on the expenditure of the Fund and the results achieved.
