## Amendment to the Draft Programme and Budget for 2014-2017 (37 C/5)

### Proposed modification:

#### Modify paragraph 1 (b) (i) as follows:

- (i) mobilize the social and human sciences to enable social transformations and intercultural dialogue conducive to **strengthened social responsibilities, hence** social inclusion, poverty eradication, elimination of discrimination, violence prevention

**Explanatory note:**

Considering the emphasis put on the issue of “social responsibility” by UNESCO, the proposed modification will assist measures to:

1. Review the importance of empowering and social support;
2. Review the conceptual definition of the term “social responsibilities” and offer guidelines to develop and promote it at societal level;
3. Identify social capacities for removing challenges faced with regarding social management and social support; and
4. Encourage public and private organizations to pursue and to foster social responsibilities.

In the long run, these will help achieve UNESCO’s objectives of social inclusion, poverty eradication, elimination of discrimination, violence prevention and peaceful resolution with a foresight approach and a multidisciplinary, smart strategic objective, as defined in paragraph 1(b)(i).
