Modify paragraph 1 (c) (iii), as follows:

- (iii) continue to advocate for education among competing development priorities and lead the debate on EFA and education-related development agenda post 2015. UNESCO will steer international debate on critical issues and emerging challenges for education; coordinate EFA partners in a last “big push” to accelerate progress towards EFA and facilitate equal partnerships and technical cooperation between developing countries and new donors; and continue efforts to build a broad coalition of partners for

education to share knowledge and experiences among diverse stakeholders in education; **these efforts are supported by public partnerships in the academic infrastructure of the Member States;**
