1. 3. After the conclusion of each debate the representatives of the Director-General will reply to questions that delegates may have raised.

4. Furthermore, the CI Commission will hold a special event entitled: "Launch of the first phase of the "*Women in African History: An E-Learning tool*" project on Wednesday 13 November 2013 at 2 p.m. in Room XI.

5. The report of the Commission will be submitted directly to the Plenary.

6. The Chairperson would like to remind delegates of the importance of the Commission's work and the large number of items to be treated in only 4 meetings. It is therefore essential to keep to the timetable and to avoid delays. Consequently, the speaking time allotted to individual interventions will be strictly limited to a maximum of **two minutes** for all debates. An exception will be accorded to the debate on item 4.2, for which a maximum of **three minutes** will be allowed per speaker.

7. To ensure efficient time-management, the Chairperson proposes to adopt the decision on item 5.4 without debate, as contained in 37 C/1 Prov. Rev. This item concerns the establishment of category 2 institutes and centres and refers to document 37 C/18, Part XVI, Proposal for the establishment in Oregon, USA, of an international institute for intercultural dialogue and conflict-sensitive reporting (IIDCSR).

8. The Chairperson has decided that, if the examination of an agenda item is concluded earlier than foreseen, the Commission will continue its deliberation with the next debate on the agenda without delay.

9. In presenting this timetable, the Chairperson would like to raise the attention of delegates to the fact that documents 37 C/REP/15 and 37 C/REP/16 are only submitted for information on the activities of the International Programme for the Development of Communication and the Information for All Programme. They do not require debate.
