Mr Ambassador,

On behalf of the Director-General, I have pleasure in informing you that, within the framework of the UNESCO Co-Sponsored Fellowships Programme, and thanks to the generous support of the Saudi Committee for the Relief of the Palestinian People, UNESCO is launching the project "Enhancing Palestinian Human Capital: Study grant to 129 Palestinian students studying abroad".

This important initiative represents a further step in the Organization's longstanding effort to assist the Palestinian people, seeking to increase educational opportunities for Palestinian students and help young qualified Palestinians contribute to the reconstruction and development process in the Palestinian territories.

The assistance offered under this project, in the form of study grants, will offer 129 Palestinian students starting their academic studies in the autumn of 2008 the opportunity to access higher education institutions abroad and complete a first university degree in 2010 (technical diploma) or in 2012 (bachelor degree). Special consideration will be given to female candidates and students coming from the most disadvantaged areas.

Candidatures should be addressed to the Permanent Observer Mission of Palestine to UNESCO and received by **30<sup>th</sup> June 2008 at the latest** on the application form annexed to this letter (Annex I). Annnex II (attached) provides detailed information concerning the qualifications required, the general conditions governing the award of fellowships and the procedure for the submission of the applications. You will also find enclosed a UNESCO Form of language proficiency certificate (Annex III). All relevant information can also be found under "fellowships" on the UNESCO website (www.unesco.org).

## ANNEX I

UNESCO/Saudi Arabia FIT Fellowships Programme

#### **1.INTRODUCTION.**

This project proposal builds on UNESCO's belief that investing in education, in particular higher education, constitutes a key strategy to economic recovery in the Palestinian territories, as more qualified young Palestinians will be able to contribute to the reconstruction and development of the Palestinian society.

The assistance offered under this project aims at providing financial assistance to needy Palestinian students so that they may enter higher education institutions abroad during the autumn session of 2008 and complete a first diploma (either a BA or a technical diploma). A total number of 129 students will receive study grants (93 technical degree and 36 bachelor degree students) starting their academic studies in Fall 2008 (105 Students for Arab and Asian countries, 18 students for Europe and 6 students for the US and Canada) until completion of their first higher education degree either in 2010 (technical degree) or 2012 (bachelor degree).

### 2. DURATION

Until December 2012 (4 years)

### 3. QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

A. Applicants must meet the following general criteria:

- a) Candidates starting their BA or technical diploma during Fall Semester 2008.
- b) Palestinian candidates whose parents are living in the Palestinian Territories, or who are themselves living either in the Palestinian Territories, or in refugee camps outside of the Palestinian Territories, are eligible.
- c) Candidates holding a secondary school diploma.
- d) Candidates of maximum 25 years of age.
- e) Candidates with good school records who may be expected to make significant contribution to their country on return.
- f) Candidates must be proficient in reading and writing the language of instruction in the proposed country of study
- g) Candidates for technical diplomas will be given priority. Priority will also be given to Bachelor candidates in the following, labour-market oriented, subjects: Science, Engineering, Business and Finance, Medicine, Fine Arts.
- h) Special consideration will be given to **female** candidates and students coming from the most disadvantaged areas.

- i) Location of university/ technical college: Arab region and Asia (70%), Europe (20%), USA and Canada (10%).
- B. The following documents must be attached to the application form in duplicate:
  - a) The UNESCO Fellowship application form duly completed in duplicate.
  - b) Two recent photographs should be included with the form.
  - c) Certified copies of degrees or diplomas in duplicate together with a record of the previous year's grades
  - d) One copy of the identity card.
  - e) Original certificate of enrolment in an academic institution in the Arab region, Europe, Asia or USA.<sup>1</sup>
  - f) The language proficiency certificate if the language of study is not the mother tongue or the medium of previous study for several years(Annex III)

Only selected candidates will be required to submit a medical examination report.

### 4. SELECTION OF BENEFICIARIES

The procedures set out below will be followed for the selection of the candidates:

- i) On the basis of the above-mentioned criteria, application form, and documentation, the selection will be done by a selection committee comprised of members of the UNESCO Secretariat and the Permanent Observer Mission of Palestine to UNESCO.
- ii) The list of the pre-selected candidates, as well as other necessary documents as above will be forwarded to the UNESCO Secretariat through the Permanent Observer Mission of Palestine to UNESCO.
- iii) The final approval of candidates under the project will be done by UNESCO.
- iv) Students awarded must submit evidence of academic achievement certified by the host institution after each academic term.
