Note on the appointment of the CCNGO/EFA Coordination Group

As proposed by the Fifth Meeting of the Collective Consultation of NGOs on EFA (CCNGO/EFA)¹, and in line with the reform of the global EFA coordination architecture and the new Directives concerning UNESCO's partnership with non-governmental organizations², the CCNGO/EFA Working Procedures have been revised jointly by the CCNGO/EFA Ad hoc group and UNESCO³.

In line with the Working Procedures (paragraph 6.3), the Sixth Meeting of the CCNGO/EFA (24-26 October 2012, Paris) is due to establish a new Coordination Group.

In this context, UNESCO invited on 4 October CCNGO/EFA member organisations to submit candidatures for the Coordination Group which will consist of two international focal points, five regional focal points, two representatives of the CCNGO/EFA membership at large and one representative of the UNESCO/NGO Liaison Committee.

By the 15 October deadline, 20 nominations were received from 19 CCNGO/EFA member NGOs⁴:

- International focal points: Seven eligible nominations.
- Regional focal points:
 - Asia: Two nominations, one of which eligible⁵.
 - Africa: Six nominations, one of which eligible.
 - Arab states: One eligible nomination.
 - Europe and North America: No nominations.
 - Latin America and the Caribbean: One eligible nomination.
- Representatives of the CCNGO/EFA at large: Two eligible nominations.

As more than two eligible nominations were received for the international focal points, the CCNGO/EFA Ad hoc group will facilitate the pre-selection of candidates by consensus or elections among representatives of international NGOs before 26 October.

The establishment of the Coordination Group will be validated on Friday 26 October during Session 5.
