Draft Council Decision

The Intergovernmental Council for the Information for All Programme,

<u>Recalling</u> the mandate, programme objectives and implementation principles laid down for the Programme in the Decision of the Executive Board that established it,

<u>Recalling</u> that the Programme's specific objectives are set out in its Strategic Plan (2008-2013) endorsed by the Executive Board at its 180th session in October 2008,

Recalling the role of the Council in implementing IFAP (Article 5 of the Statutes),

<u>Further recalling</u> that under Article 8 of the Statutes, the Secretariat of the Council shall be provided by the Director-General of UNESCO, who shall place at the Council's disposal the staff and other means required for its efficient operation,

<u>Noting</u> the increased role of IFAP in UNESCO's "Communication and Information" programme, as provided for in document 35 C/5 adopted by the General Conference,

<u>Aware</u> that the Executive Board has repeatedly called for increasing the efficiency and effectiveness of IFAP and has requested the Director-General to assist in this endeavour by providing additional funds from the regular budget, extrabudgetary funding and staff support,

<u>Recognizing</u> that the IFAP Council and Bureau have primary responsibility for the success of the programme,

Noting that under the Statutes the Bureau has mainly formal and non-executive functions and responsibilities,

<u>Noting</u> also that the Bureau is considered as a subsidiary body of the Council and shall discharge such duties as the Council may confer upon it,

<u>Invites</u> the Bureau to assume the role of the executive body of the Council, actively cooperating with the Secretariat in implementing the goals of UNESCO as defined in document 35 C/5;

<u>Invites</u> the Chair and Bureau members to agree on a division of labour within the Bureau, resulting in the acceptance by Bureau members of responsibilities for, in particular, contacts and regular cooperation with Council members; development and operation of working groups; cooperation with National IFAP Committees; fundraising; IFAP projects and visibility; oversight of the IFAP website and the IFAP Information Society Observatory; outreach to, and contacts with, various stakeholder groups and organizations; operational relations with UNESCO Member States that are not elected members of the Council;

<u>Requests</u> the Director-General to take the appropriate measures in order to ensure that the Bureau is fully assisted in discharging these responsibilities.
