Introduction

At the EABRN-10 meeting held in Terelj National Park, Mongolia during September 2007, Chinese Member proposed to host the EABRN-11 at China, and it was warmly accepted by the meeting.

The EABRN priority issues such as implementation of Seville Strategy, Madrid Action Plan, conservation policies, ecotourism, capacity building, the linkage between cultural and biological diversity and Transboundary biodiversity conservation will be discussed. As always, a Biosphere Reserve field evaluation will be carried out at Wuyishan Biosphere Reserve which is also part of Natural Heritage.

Objectives

The EABRN-11 aims particularly to achieve the following objectives:

- Exchange information and experience on conservation and management of biosphere reserves and other similarly managed protected areas in the East Asian countries in light of the Seville Strategy, Madrid Action Plan, Adaptation to Climate Change and Biosphere Reserve as learning site for Sustainable Development;
- Review and update EABRN activities on its priority issues;
- Carry out a field evaluation for the Wuyishan Biosphere Reserve;
- Elaborate an activity plan for EABRN cooperation for the period of 2010 \sim 2011.

Theme

The workshop will mainly focused on "Implementation of MAB's Seville Strategy and Madrid Action Plan in Biosphere Reserves" in addition there will be special presentations on "Biosphere Reserve: Learning Site for Sustainable Development". Discussion among representatives from six EABRN member states and other countries will be major style of meeting organization.

Expected outputs

- Suggestions and recommendations for conservation of Biosphere Reserves under Seville Strategy and Madrid Action Plan in East Asian countries;
- Comments and suggestions for improving conservation and management of the Wuyishan Biosphere Reserve;
- A work plan for EABRN activities in the year of 2010 and 2011;
- An EABRN-11 meeting proceedings

Participants

- Representatives from six EABRN member states (China, DPR Korea, Japan, Mongolia, R. Korea and Russian Federation) and also from other countries as special representatives

- Chinese representatives from key governmental agencies, Biosphere Reserves and local communities
- Participants from the relevant organizations such as UNESCO, UNDP, CBPF, IUCN, WWF, etc.

The total number of participants is expected to be about 40-50.
