UNESCO Bioethics Core Curriculum

- based on principles of Universal Declaration on Bioethics and Human Rights
- proposes a minimum program
- flexibility: does not impose a particular model
- global outreach: useful in all regions
- heterogeneity: variety and diversity around a common core
- *aim:* to facilitate the introduction of bioethics primarily in medical and science schools

- 2. development of educational resources

- 3. test phase: introduction in interested universities in different regions with uniform assessment and possible revision
