### BIOETHICS EDUCATION: TWO LATINAMERICAN EXPERIENCES

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#### Two Latinamerican Experiences

- Implementation of UNESCO Bioethics Core Curriculum (BCC) at the Litoral National University (UNL)- Santa Fe (Argentina)
- Permanent Education Programme on Bioethics (PEPB) for Latin America and the Caribbean-UNESCO REDBIOETICA

Both are based on binding Bioethics and Human Rights from a Latinamerican point of view of bioethical issues.

### Implementation of the UNESCO Bioethics Core Curriculum at the Litoral National University (UNL)

- UNL: Created in 1919. 9 Faculties. 4 University Schools. 100 Degree Careers. 38.500 students. 52 Postgraduated Careers. 2.600 students
- UNESCO BCC: It will be implementated to all Degree Careers
- Academic Executive Unity: "Cátedra Abierta de Bioética" (Academic Secretary of UNL)
- Cooperation Programme on Bioethics and Ethics in Science- Regional Sciences Office of UNESCO -Montevideo

#### **Stages Performed during 2009**

- Introduction in Teaching Bioethics Seminar dictated by UNESCO Redbioetica Professors (March 2009)
- Diffussion of the Proposal and Agreement of common issues among Authorities of the different Faculties (April-May 2009)
- Creation of the Commission at UNL for the Study of UNESCO BCC implementation (May 2009)
- Memorandum of Understanding UNESCO-UNL

### Activities of UNL Commission (May-November 2009)

- Diagnostic of situation about Teaching Bioethical Issues and Problems in UNL.
- Adaptation of UNESCO BCC to Latinamerican and National Reality.
- Discussion of specific contents for the different Faculties.
- Proposal and calling for teachers for integrating a Teacher Team.

#### **Next Steps (1)**

- Training Seminar for Teachers of UNL on Bioethics (March-June 2010)
  - √ 180 Hours. Final Evaluation
  - ✓ Professors: Experts of UNESCO
  - Redbioética and UNL
  - ✓ Recipients: 45 Teachers of UNL

#### Next Steps (2)

- Starting of "Bioethics" Subject (August-December 2010)
  - ✓ Recipients: Students of all UNL Careers who completed the 1st. year
  - ✓ Professors: UNL Teacher Team
  - √ 60 Hours ( 5 Hours per week)
  - ✓ Activities: 50% theory 50% practice (Analysis of ethics problems based on local cases)
  - ✓ Term and final exam
- Outcoming Evaluation: December 2010

#### **Achievements**

- Commitment from UNL's Authorities about the future professionals' training
- Democratic and participatory process ⇒
   Commission integrated by representatives
   from all Faculties.
- Students and professors sensitized because of the proposal.

#### Challenges

- Coherence of an educational project implemented from a sole Chair taking into account particular situations in each Faculty.
- Interdisciplinary Teacher Team.
- To attend the increasing demand of permanent training.

## Permanent Education Programme (PEPB) on Bioethics for Latin America and the Caribbean-UNESCO REDBIOETICA

#### **General Goal**

To train professionals from different fields in the necessary basic knowledge to develop educational consultive and normative tasks on Bioethics. Frame of Reference: Bioethics based on a Universal Conception of Human Rights attending Historical, Social and Cultural Values having Latinamerican Reality as its setting.

### PEPB UNESCO REDBIOETICA Courses

- Introduction to Research Ethics on Human Beings (Beginning 2006) At present attending 4th. Cohort.
- Introduction to Clinical and Social Bioethics (Beginning 2007) At presente attending 3rd. Cohort.

#### PEPB UNESCO REDBIOETICA

#### **Characteristics**

- Amount of hours: 220
- Type: On line course. Virtual classes (debate forums, chat, video conferences)
- Language: Spanish Portuguese
   Bibliography: Spanish Portuguese -English
- Duration: 10 months. (4 modules 2 month each + development and evaluation of final work)
- UNESCO Scholarships: Bioethics Programme of Montevideo Unesco Office supported the students scholarships.

### Recipients

- Health Care Professionals and other professions related to Social Sciences
- Ethics Committees' members.
- Community Leaders, Politicians, NGO's Leaders with infuence in specific areas.
- People interested in Bioethics who have the capacity to carry out an educational project or in Public Administration.

### Applicant Selection Criterion

- Antecedents (professional skills, current relation to Bioethics, previous training, etc.)
- Institutional influence
- Regional accessibility. Distribution of the places per country

### Some Numbers

- 395 professionals trained (2006-2007-2008)
- 291 are attending their training (2009)
- 863 professionals from 22 countries have been part of the Programme
- 650 UNESCO scholarships
- 329 Application Projects approved.
  - 209 Research Ethics on Human Beings120 Clinical and Social Bioethics
- 385 professionals interacting in PEPB former students forums.

### PEPB UNESCO REDBIOETICA Perspectives

- To incorporate new members to UNESCO
   Redbioética for Latin America and the Caribbean ⇒
   Increase of its Academic Production.
- Permanent and increasing Training.
- Incidence of training on Bioethics in Public Politics of each country.
- Support: Commitment of the institutions in training their professionals on Bioethics.
