2008-2009, **Guyana**, Launching of the First Forum of Ministers of Social Development in co-operation with CARICOM

SOUTH ASIA

2008, March, New Dehli**, India,** Second Forum of Ministers of this region.

Regional/subregional Fora of Ministers foreseen to be organized during 2008-2009

SADC

2008 and 2009, possibly organized together with South Africa

East African Community (EAC)

2008, **Arusha, Tanzania**. Inaugural/launching meeting at the HQs of the EAC

Maghreb region and Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon and Syria

2008, Jordan, Second Forum of Ministers of this region

ECOWAS 2008, Senegal.

Possibly in cooperation with the ECOWAS Secretariat.



Common aspects / guidelines

- Main focus or theme for each Forum meeting is decided, in consultation with UNESCO, by the Country hosting the Forum
- Declaration adopted at each Forum meeting establishing action plan
- Follow-up assured by President and a rotating secretariat

- Technical meeting of the regional Focal Points of each Regional Forum of Ministers, (UNESCO Headquarters, November, 2006).
- Round Table of Ministers of Social Development; South Africa,
 Argentina, Greece, Kenya, Mali, Morocco, Pakistan and
 Venezuela (Kenya, Nairobi, 2007).
- Participation of 19 Ministers of Social Development in the eight session of the MOST Intergovernmental Council (Paris, 2007).
- During all the regional Fora of Ministers (biennium 2006-2007),
 at least one Minister from other regions have participated.
