Madam/Sir,

On behalf of the Director-General, I am pleased to inform you that the International Center for Sustainable Energy Development (ISEDC) in Moscow is offering thirty (30) fellowships of four-week duration within the framework of the UNESCO/ISEDC Co-Sponsored Fellowships Programme.

The energy questions being the priority for the international community and the United Nations System, these fellowships are aimed at enhancing the capacity-building and human resources development in the field of sustainable and renewable energy in developing countries and countries in transition.

The training will be held in specialized institutions in the Russian Federation from **1 to 26 October 2012**. The medium of instruction being in Russian, only candidates proficient in this language are eligible to apply.

The Annex II to this letter provides detailed information concerning the fields of study proposed, the qualifications required, the facilities offered, the general conditions governing the award of fellowships and the procedures for the submission of applications. To enable the Selection Committee to make the best possible choice, I should be grateful if you could arrange for your country's nominees (a maximum of 2 candidates) to complete and attach — in as detailed manner as possible — the required forms and documents. All applications should be sent in duplicate to UNESCO Fellowships Section not later than 31 May 2012. An advance copy may be sent by e-mail (l.pigeonneau@unesco.org) or by fax (33.1.45685503).

This Programme is offered in open competition. As the number of fellowships put at the disposal of UNESCO under this Programme is limited, only candidates who demonstrate outstanding intellectual qualities, imagination and personal commitment will have a chance of being selected.

#### UNESCO/ISEDC CO-SPONSORED FELLOWSHIPS PROGRAMME – 2012

#### I. INTRODUCTION

In line with the strategy and objectives of the approved UNESCO Programme and Budget for the Fellowships Programme Section, the UNESCO Category II International Center for Sustainable Energy Development (ISEDC) in Moscow (Russian Federation) is offering thirty (30) fellowships of four weeks (4) duration each in 2012. The aim of this fellowships programme is to enhance the capacity-building and human resources development in the area of sustainable and renewable energy sources in developing countries and countries in transition. The training activities in the framework of these fellowships are tenable in specialized institutions in the Russian Federation. The medium of instruction will be Russian. UNESCO will solicit applications from the developing countries and countries in transition (list of invited Member States in Annex I).

#### 2. FIELDS OF STUDY

The candidates may choose to study in the following fields of study, which are aligned with UNESCO's objectives and programme priorities, as per approved 35 C/5 and in accordance with the decisions made by the Executive Board (161 EX/Decision 3.6.3 and 165 EX/Decision 8.6):

- (a) Energy and sustainable development;
- (b) Ecological management of energy resources;
- (c) Renewable energy;
- (d) Sustainable and renewable energy power generation.

#### 3. **DURATION**

Four week duration: from 1<sup>st</sup> - 26 October 2012.

#### 4. QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

Candidates must meet the following criteria:

- (a) Holder of at least a BSc degree or BA in Economics;
- (b) Proficient in the Russian language;
- (c) Not more than 45 years of age;
- (d) Be in good health, both mentally and physically.

#### 5. PROCEDURES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

- (a) All applications should be **endorsed** by the National Commission for UNESCO and must be duly completed in **English** or **French** with the following attachments in **DUPLICATE**:
  - The prescribed UNESCO fellowship application form;
  - Six photographs;
  - Certified photocopies of Diplomas
  - Certificate of Russian Language proficiency minimum of **500** hours of language training (if Russian is not the mother tongue or was the language of instruction for some years of study);
  - Subsequently, for those who have been selected, the UNESCO medical examination form duly completed by a recognized physician (not more than four months before the actual date of studies). The prescribed form of which will be sent along with the letter of award. Expenses incurred in the constitution of the medical dossiers will not be reimbursed.
- (b) Files which are incomplete or received after the deadline for the submission of applications and candidatures, and do not fulfil the requirements mentioned above, will not be considered.
- (c) Each invited Member State is requested to nominate not more than **two** (2) candidates.

#### 6. SELECTION OF BENEFICIARIES

- (a) The final selection of beneficiaries lies with ISEDC.
- (b) The National Commission of selected fellows will be duly informed by UNESCO and the letter of award will immediately follow.
- (c) UNESCO will authorize the departure of beneficiaries who have completely complied with the requirements stipulated in the letter of award.
- (e) Candidates not informed of their selection by 1<sup>st</sup> September 2012 should consider that their applications have not been approved.

#### 7. FACILITIES OFFERED BY ISEDC

- i) Beneficiaries will be exempt of paying tuition fees for the entire duration of studies/training;
- ii) Fellows will undertake studies/training under the supervision of an advisor or study director that will be provided by the host institution;

- iii) The donor Government will pay stipends to beneficiaries on a monthly basis, in local currency. The stipend amounting to **eight hundred (800) US** dollars is intended to cover living expenses such as accommodation, meals, pocket expenses, and incidentals.
- iv) ISEDC will assist in obtaining modest housing for the fellows.

#### 8. FACILITIES OFFERED BY UNESCO

- (a) UNESCO will cover the cost of the round-trip international travel at the most economical rate and the most direct flights.
- (b) UNESCO will pay a one-time travel allowance amounting to **US\$100** (one hundred US dollars) prior to the fellows' departure for the Russian Federation.
- (c) Health insurance. To avail of this entitlement, beneficiaries should be declared medically fit by the UNESCO Medical Service that examines the complete medical dossiers.

#### 9 OTHER CONDITIONS

- (a) No provisions can be made to finance or lodge the fellows' family members.
- (b) Beneficiaries will be required to submit to UNESCO a final report upon termination of the fellowship. This report could be written in **English** or in **French** and a copy of which will be furnished to ISEDC.

#### 10. VISA

Selected fellows from countries where there are Russian Federation Embassies or Consulates must obtain their entry visa in their country **prior** to their departure. Fellows from countries where no such embassy/consulate exists must secure their visa through the nearest country where the Embassy or Consulate of the Russian Federation can be found.

UNESCO and ISEDC provide no allowance to defray passport and visa expenses.
