

THE AMILCAR CABRAL FOUNDATION

The Amílcar Cabral Foundation is a non-governmental organization that pursues the aims, the findings and the work of Amílcar Cabral (1924-1973), as well as the various studies on the founder of the African Party for the Independence of Guinea and Cape Verde (P.A.I.G.C.) which contribute to his legacy.

The Foundation's area of interest lies in the safeguarding and enrichment of the cultural heritage of the people of Cape Verde, and organizes artistic, educational, scientific and social solidarity activities.

It promotes activities that defend the values of tolerance, solidarity and cooperation among peoples and countries.

With the values it defends and the aims it pursues, the Amílcar Cabral Foundation carries out its objectives through the organization of meetings, conferences and seminars on a range of subjects to foster debate on current issues.

Among the Foundation's main projects are a "Centre for African Studies", which was established to symbolize the importance of relations with other African countries.
