Participants in the PLA workshop conducted between 25 <sup>th</sup> May-31 <sup>st</sup> May 2006 by FSPV, Fisheries Department and Wan Smolbag has identified the poor waste management in Anelcauhat as a threat to our marine environment as people continue to use the sea as their dumping site. Therefore this project will focus on the control of waste in the village through best practice upon the expert advise of the Environment Unit and other relevant authorities in Vanuatu.
