From October-December, UNESCO activities in Asia-Pacific receiving prominent media coverage included the first-ever "Forum to Target the Illicit Trade of Cultural Heritage in Southeast Asia" (Bangkok, 19-21 November); the UNESCO World Conference on Education for Sustainable Development (Nagoya, Japan, 10-12 November); region-wide efforts to promote disaster risk reduction education; as well as several Asia-Pacific additions to the Intangible Cultural Heritage list. Website viewership was up from the previous quarter in October and November, though saw the annual drop-off towards the end of the year holiday season. Social media numbers continued to rise, with posts tied to the Nobel Prize win of Malala Yousafzai obtaining all-time highs in views.


