

Nearly SIX IN TEN LGBT youth

were bullied in the past month because of their sexual orientation / gender identity

Bullied LGBT youth experienced different types of violence:




ONE IN FOUR

RESPONSES



Nearly one in four that did nothing said this was because...

"nothing would happen even if someone were told"

Of those that did something:

52% fought back
51% spoke to a friend
8% spoke to a teacher
6% spoke to a guidance counsellor
3% spoke to a school disciplinarian
2% spoke to other school staff
1% spoke to a school director

IMPACT Bullied LGBT youth were

2x more likely to have missed school in the month

Nearly 4x more likely to be depressed
7x more likely to have tried to commit suicide
than their non-bullied peers

ACTIONS NEEDED



Establish and enforce anti-bullying policies

covering students of all genders



Ensure safe spaces to prevent LGBT bullying

Include content on sexual and gender diversity in related subjects



Empower LGBT students to participate fully and act ively in school life

Build teacher capacity and understanding of sexual and gender diversity

Establish Links to support for affected students
