- Completed applications must be received by TRF from sponsor Rotarians no later than 15 June of the year in which studies begin.
- Scholars are selected in a competitive process. Candidates are chosen based on their ability to have a significant, positive impact on global water and sanitation issues during their career. Successful applicants will have a strong academic background, significant and relevant professional experience, and demonstrated leadership in the community.
- Applications must be completed electronically or typed, not handwritten.
