



Mr. Alexander Trepelkov, Director of the Financing for Development Office (since January 2010) at the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UN-DESA), is responsible for secretariat support to the intergovernmental follow-up process of the 2002 Monterrey Consensus, 2008 Doha Declaration and 2015 Addis Agenda on Financing for Development, aimed at promoting policy coherence, coordination and cooperation at all levels in substantive areas of domestic resource mobilization, international development cooperation, private capital flows, trade, external debt, technology transfer, capacity building and the global financial architecture. At present, he leads the work on promoting the contribution of the Financing for Development outcomes to the means of implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, including the Sustainable Development Goals. His previous assignments at UN-DESA were in the areas of Development Finance (2000-2009) and Macroeconomics and Development Policy (1989-1999). Prior to joining the UN Secretariat, he worked in the Foreign Service of the former Soviet Union.
