Excellency,


I am pleased to inform you that pursuant to General Assembly resolution 68/302, I will convene the second informal interactive consultation with all relevant stakeholders of the World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS) on 19 October 2015 at UN Headquarters in New York as part of the preparatory process of the General Assembly WSIS review.

At the first consultation convened on 2 July 2015 by H.E. Mr. Kutesa, President of the 69th Session of the General Assembly, WSIS stakeholders provided inputs for the draft outcome document. Based on these and other inputs collected from all relevant stakeholders, the non-paper has been drafted and circulated for comments. The zero draft is expected to be available in the last week of September.

The purpose of this upcoming consultation is to provide an opportunity for all relevant WSIS stakeholders to comment on the zero draft of the outcome document. These inputs will feed into the intergovernmental negotiation process.

I encourage you to participate actively in this consultation. The time and venue will be announced in the Journal. A concept note and a provisional programme will be available in due course.
