Listing as a Non-Self-Governing Territory

The **Cayman Islands** has been on the United Nations list of Non-Self-Governing Territory since 1946, following the declaration of the intention by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to transmit information on **Jamaica** (under which the Cayman Islands had fallen) under Article 73 *e* of the Charter of the United Nations.
