Listing as a Non-Self-Governing Territory

French Polynesia was on the United Nations list of Non-Self-Governing Territories from 1946 to 1947, following transmission of information on **French Establishments in Oceania** by France under Article 73 *e* of the Charter of the United Nations. In 2013, the General Assembly re-inscribed French Polynesia, by recognizing that “French Polynesia remains a Non-Self-Governing Territory within the meaning of the Charter”.
