- 1) Norway, jointly with the other like-minded States on targeted sanctions, hereby pledges to submit, by the end of this year and by 2014, to the UN Security Council suggestions on ways to strengthen the UN sanctions system by further improving fair and clear procedures, especially with regard to enhancing the scope and mandate of the Ombudsperson.
- 2) Norway, together with Argentina, Austria, Chile, Costa Rica, Greece, Slovenia, Switzerland and Uruguay, hereby pledges to contribute to efforts made at the national, regional and international levels to promote truth, justice, reparation and guarantees of non-recurrence and in particular to lend their support to the work of the Special Rapporteur created by the Human Rights Council to deal with these questions.
- 3) Norway, hereby pledges that it, for the period 2012-2013, will provide financing for experts on constitutional reform and power-sharing that are part of the Mediation Stand by Team of the Department of Political Affairs of the UN Secretariat
