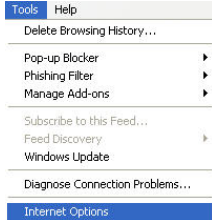


# OAJ EFILING PORTAL – BROWSER SETTINGS

**You must use Internet Explorer (version 6, 7 or 8) when filing through the eFiling portal.  
Other browsers are not supported and are not fully functional.**

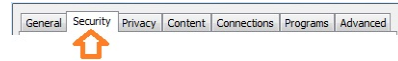
The following settings are **optional** and are suggested only to prevent redundant browser warnings.

## Internet Options

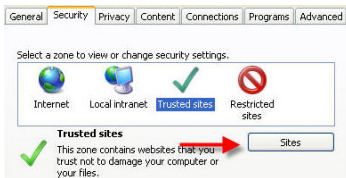


In Internet Explorer, select “Tools” from the menu bar and open “Internet Options”.

Open the “Security” tab:

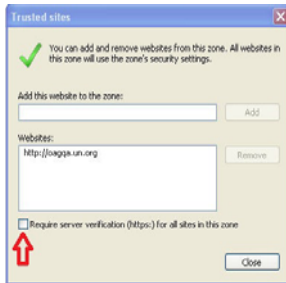


## Security Tab



In the Securities tab, select the “Trusted Sites” zone and click on the “Sites” button.

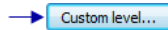
## Trusted Sites



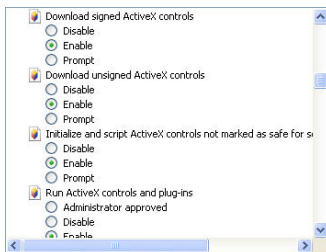
Un-tick the “Request server verification” tick-box.

Type <https://efilinginternaljustice.un.org/> in the “Add to zone” field and click on the “Add” button. Also add <http://efilinginternaljustice.un.org/>. Click on the “Close” button.

In the Securities Tab, click on the “Custom level” button.



## Enable Active-X and Scripting



Set the security levels for your Trusted Sites to be as allowing as possible, that is: tick “enable” for all options.



Click “OK” to save and close your Trusted Sites zone settings



Enter the **custom level** settings for the Internet zone. Change the setting for “Display mixed content” from “prompt” to “enable”. Click “OK” to save.



Click “OK” again to exit your Internet Options.
