10. Central African region

During the period under review, the Security Council held four meetings and issued three presidential statements in connection with the situation in the Central African region.

Against the backdrop of the persistent crisis in the Central African Republic and its growing regional impact, the Council focused on threat of terrorism posed by the expansion of Boko Haram terrorist activities into countries in the sub-region. The Council further condemned the attacks, war crimes and crimes against humanity carried out by the Lord's Resistance Army (LRA) in the sub-region. The Council also focused on the role of the United Nations Regional Office for Central Africa (UNOCA) and other UN regional missions in dealing with the armed groups, maritime insecurity in the Gulf of Guinea and piracy, terrorism and transnational organized crime in the sub-region.⁴³ In an effort to improve international co-ordination against the LRA, the Council called for UNOCA, missions in the region and relevant UN agencies to implement the UN's Regional Strategy, as well as for greater co-operation between the UN, AU and the Economic Community of Central African States (ECCAS).⁴⁴ In addition to the above, the Council in 2015 focused on the political tensions arising from the electoral cycles affecting several countries in Central Africa.

During the period under review, the mandate of UNOCA was extended on 21 July 2015 for a period of three years, from 31 August 2015 until 31 August 2018, by virtue of a letter from the President of the Security Council addressed to the Secretary-General.⁴⁵
