

## 2. The situation in Liberia

During the period under review, the Security Council held 14 meetings in connection with the situation in Liberia, including three closed meetings with troop- and police-contributing countries,<sup>4</sup> and adopted six resolutions, all under Chapter VII of the Charter. The Council, inter alia, heard briefings by the Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Mission in Liberia (UNMIL), the Chair of the Liberia country-specific configuration of the Peacebuilding Commission and the Under-Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations.

During the period under review, the Council extended the mandate of UNMIL<sup>5</sup> for periods of three months, nine months and one year, respectively.<sup>6</sup> By resolution [2215 \(2015\)](#), the Council authorized the resumption of the drawdown of UNMIL, which had been suspended since September 2014 due to the Ebola outbreak, and reaffirmed its expectation that the Government of Liberia would assume fully its complete security responsibilities from UNMIL no later than 30 June 2016. By resolution [2237 \(2015\)](#), the Council decided to terminate the travel and financial measures imposed by resolution [1521 \(2003\)](#) and resolution [1532 \(2004\)](#) respectively. During the period under review, the mandate of the Panel of Experts was extended twice for 10 months.<sup>7</sup>
