15. The situation in Mali

During the period under review, the Security Council held fourteen meetings, adopted two resolutions and issued three presidential statements in connection with the situation in Mali. The Council also met twice, once in 2014 and once in 2015, with troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Mali (MINUSMA) pursuant to resolution <u>1353 (2001)</u>.

During 2014, the Council oversaw the deployment of troops to MINUSMA, which was established in 2013, and received regular briefings on the overall political process and the deteriorating security situation in the north of the country. The Council visited Mali from 1 to 3 February 2014 and met with representatives of the Government, local authorities and civil society.⁶⁰ By resolution <u>2164 (2014)</u>, the Council extended the mandate of MINUSMA until 30 June 2015 focusing on areas, such as ensuring security, stabilizing and protecting civilians, supporting political dialogue and reconciliation, the re-establishment of State authority, the rebuilding of the security sector, and the promotion and protection of human rights in the country.

In 2015, the focus shifted to the peace process that culminated in the signature by all parties of the Agreement on Peace and Reconciliation in Mali on 20 June 2015. By resolution <u>2227 (2015)</u>, the Council extended the mandate of MINUSMA until 30 June 2016 refocusing on the support, monitoring and supervision of the ceasefire, the support of the implementation of the Agreement on Peace and Reconciliation, good offices, protection of civilians and the promotion and protection of human rights.⁶¹
