38. Post-conflict peacebuilding

During the period under review, the Security Council held four meetings in connection with the item entitled "Post-conflict peacebuilding", and adopted one presidential statement. In two of the meetings, held on 14 March 2014 and 14 January 2015, the Council considered reports of the Secretary-General on peacebuilding in the aftermath of conflict. Both meetings were followed by informal interactive dialogues (IIDs). In addition, at the meeting of 14 January 2015, the Council adopted a presidential statement in which it looked forward to the outcome of the 2015 review of the Peacebuilding Architecture and to the consideration of its recommendations in order to improve the peacebuilding capacity of the United Nations. ¹³¹ During the other two meetings, held on 15 July 2014 and 25 June 2015, respectively, the Council considered the annual reports of the Peacebuilding Commission (PBC).
