## I. Item 1. Approval of minutes

## II. Item 2. Policy discussion: Guidelines for Book Cover Design

1. The Secretary introduced the policy discussion by explaining that ADG/ERI had had insisted on the production of Guidelines for Book Cover Design. The Publications Unit has prepared a draft which was discussed during the 6 August 2014 meeting of the Publications Board.

During the 6 August 2014 meeting, there were quite a lot of comments on the draft, in particular from ED and AFR. The Publications Unit has consequently revised the draft, taking into account most of the comments when they were considered appropriate.

The Secretary said that more comments could be made during the meeting and would be integrated, if they are judged to be reasonable.

- 2. The representative for ED stated that ED just wanted to make sure that the Publications Officers have a visible role.
- 3. The representative for BSP said that she would like the Ex officio Member for BSP to be given the opportunity to look at the revised draft and to comment on it upon her return at the end of the week.
  - The Secretary agreed, provided the Ex officio Member for BSP sends her comments within 24 hours of her return.
- 4. The Secretary agreed to take the comments and request above into account, and asked whether the Members had any objection to the Guidelines being approved during the meeting. There was no objection and the <u>Guidelines were</u> therefore <u>adopted</u>.

## III. Item 3. Review of publications proposals

20 proposals were presented to the Board. The Board approved 15 proposals, including 7 Category 4 proposals. 4 proposals were returned for resubmission and one proposal was withdrawn.
