III. Distribution of publications

A representative from Earthprint Ltd, the Organization's distribution partner for its publications was present and was invited to comment briefly on the Organization's processes and on the quality of its publications.

The main comments were the following:

- The Organization continues to be very thorough.
- Other agencies are less cautious: more and more publications are put online. However, online publications still have a big cost (translation costs for example).
- There is an important reduction in the number of flagship titles.
- Flagships could still be distributed globally using the old methods. However, the distribution and translation costs could be reduced if things were planned sufficiently ahead of time.
- The representative from Earthprint thus invited the sectors to discuss distribution issues in advance.
