I. The regional review of youth policies

As part of the regional strategic action framework (2016-2017) for the UN Regional Inter-Agency Technical Task Team on Young People (r-IATTTYP) in the Arab region, the regional review of youth policies aim:

- to understand the current national youth policy/ strategy processes in the Arab States/ MENA region¹ by collecting main documents (policies, strategies) together with operational mechanisms (action and monitoring plans; TORs/ organigrams of entrusted bodies for implementation and monitoring)
- 2) to collect good practices, lesson learnt in formulating implementing and monitoring policy/strategy
- 3) to produce a set of regional standards for youth policies rights-based, inclusive, participatory, gender-responsive, comprehensive, knowledge-based and evidence-informed, fully resourced, and accountable.

A regional review of youth policies/ strategies in the Arab region includes:

- a) Analysis of process including barriers, gaps, strength and weakness of existing mechanism for youth policy/strategy in Arab Member States
- b) Recommendations on youth policies standards giving special attention to civic engagement in crisis context
- c) Compendium of resource material for youth policies formulation, implementation and monitoring, good practices and experiences across the regions from NGOs and UN agencies

II. Young researchers/Interns' participation in the regional review

UNESCO and UNDP, the co-lead agencies of the activity, are recruiting <u>a team of 7 young</u> researcher/interns to carry out the research.

The intern will be trained in an aligned methodology to undertake desk and field research to collect and analyse information related to the national youth policy processes in the Arab region.

The duration of the internship is for 3-4 months starting in the first week of June 2016, including at least 2 months at UN offices either in **Beirut (UNESCO) or** in **Amman (UNDP)**.

There is no remuneration for assignment. Each candidate is expected to cover his/her own travel, accommodation, meal and all other expenses to/at the duty station. The cost for travel and participation in the induction workshop will be covered by the organizers.

¹ The geographical coverage varies from one UN agency to another.
