## Note on the appointment of the CCNGO/EFA Coordination Group 2014-2016

In line with the Working Procedures<sup>1</sup> (paragraph 6.3) of the Collective Consultation of NGOs on EFA (CCNGO/EFA), the Seventh Meeting of the CCNGO/EFA (21-23 May 2014) is due to establish a new Coordination Group.

In this context, on 23 April 2014, UNESCO invited CCNGO/EFA member organisations to submit candidatures for the Coordination Group composed of two international focal points, five regional focal points, two representatives of the CCNGO/EFA membership at large and, ex officio, one representative of the UNESCO-NGO Liaison Committee.

By the 13 May deadline, 15 nominations were received from 15 CCNGO/EFA member NGOs<sup>2</sup>:

- International focal points: Five eligible nominations.
- Regional focal points<sup>3</sup>:
  - Africa: Two nominations, one of which eligible.
  - Asia and the Pacific: One eligible nomination.
  - Arab states: One eligible nomination.
  - Europe and North America: One nomination, not eligible.
  - Latin America and the Caribbean: One eligible nomination.
- Representatives of the membership at large: Five eligible nominations.

As more than two eligible candidates were nominated for the international focal points and for representatives of the CCNGO/EFA membership at large, elections will be organized for these four seats during the 7<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the CCNGO/EFA.

The regional focal points for Africa, Asia and the Pacific, Arab states, Latin America and the Caribbean will be validated at the end of the meeting.
