<p><b>Summary of debate</b></p>	<p>- Item 3.4 (continuation) - The representative of the Director-General (Assistant Director-General for Social and Human Sciences) replied to issues raised by Member States during the debate in session 1.</p> <p>- The Chairperson opened debate 2.</p> <p>- Item 3.2 – The representative of the Director-General (Assistant Director-General for Social and Human Sciences) introduced item 3.2 on Major Programme III. The debate on this item took place. Twenty-two (22) Member States and one (1) observer took the floor. The representative of the Director-General (Assistant Director-General for Social and Human Sciences) provided her responses subsequent to the interventions by Member States. The Commission recommended to the General Conference to approve the 38 C/5 Resolution for Major Programme III as revised by the 38 C/6 and Add. Without further amendments.</p> <p>- The Commission took note of the following reports: the joint report of the International Bioethics Committee (IBC) and the Intergovernmental Bioethics Committee (IGBC), and the reports of the Management of Social Transformations (MOST) Programme, of the Intergovernmental Committee for Physical Education and Sport (CIGEPS), and of the World Commission on the Ethics of Scientific Knowledge and Technology (COMEST).</p> <p>- The Chairperson closed debate 2.</p> <p>- The Chairperson opened debate 3.</p> <p>- Item 4.9 – The representative of the Director-General (Assistant Director-General for Social and Human Sciences) introduced the item.
