Summary of debate	<p>Debate N° 3 – (continuation) - Items 7.7 and 7.4 (continuation). Debate N°3 continued with 8 Member States taking the floor. (DRs on <i>Implementation of 2011 Recommendation on the Historic Urban Landscape</i> and <i>Consolidated report on the implementation of the 1980 Recommendation on the Status of the Artist</i>). After the comments and reply of ADG/CLT to the debate, the 2 draft resolutions were adopted.</p> <p>Debate N° 4 - - Items 4.2 & 4.3 on <i>Jerusalem and the implementation of 37 C/Resolution 44</i> and <i>Implementation of 37 C/Resolution 67</i> were adopted with consensus without debate.</p> <p>Debate N°5 -Items 4.11 & 7.3 on the <i>Reinforcement of the Protection of cultural heritage and promotion of cultural pluralism in the event of armed conflict and the Reports on the measures taken for the implementation of the 1970 Convention</i> were introduced by the Chairperson who gave the floor to ADG/CLT to present the two items. After the Chairperson opened the debate, 47 Member States took the floor. Then, ADG/CLT provided comments.</p>
