Geodynamics – 2015 Project Statistics


- 925 scientists from 50 countries (> 540 from developing world)

- 3 Projects concluded first year (646, 648, 649)
- Over 250 peer-reviewed scientific articles over 6 projects
- 16 international conferences & 11 major field excursions

• Final year of project (2012-2016)

- 58 peer-reviewed papers in 2015
- Successful 2015 IGCP symposium and field workshop in Bangkok; next in Myanmar (2016) to reinvigorate collaboration with international geoscience community




