General information about Turkey

Official language: Turkish

Currency and exchange rate: Turkish Lira (TL).

1 EURO = approximately 2.18 TL

US\$1 = approximately 1.56 TL

You can change money from airport, hotel, currency exchange offices and the banks. The exchange rates in the banks are mostly higher, so it is better to change money from exchange offices.

The hotel uses the exchange rate from Central Bank of Turkish Republic and adds approximately 2% to this rate.

Time zone: GMT + 2 hours in the entire country (seven hours ahead of U.S. Eastern Standard Time).

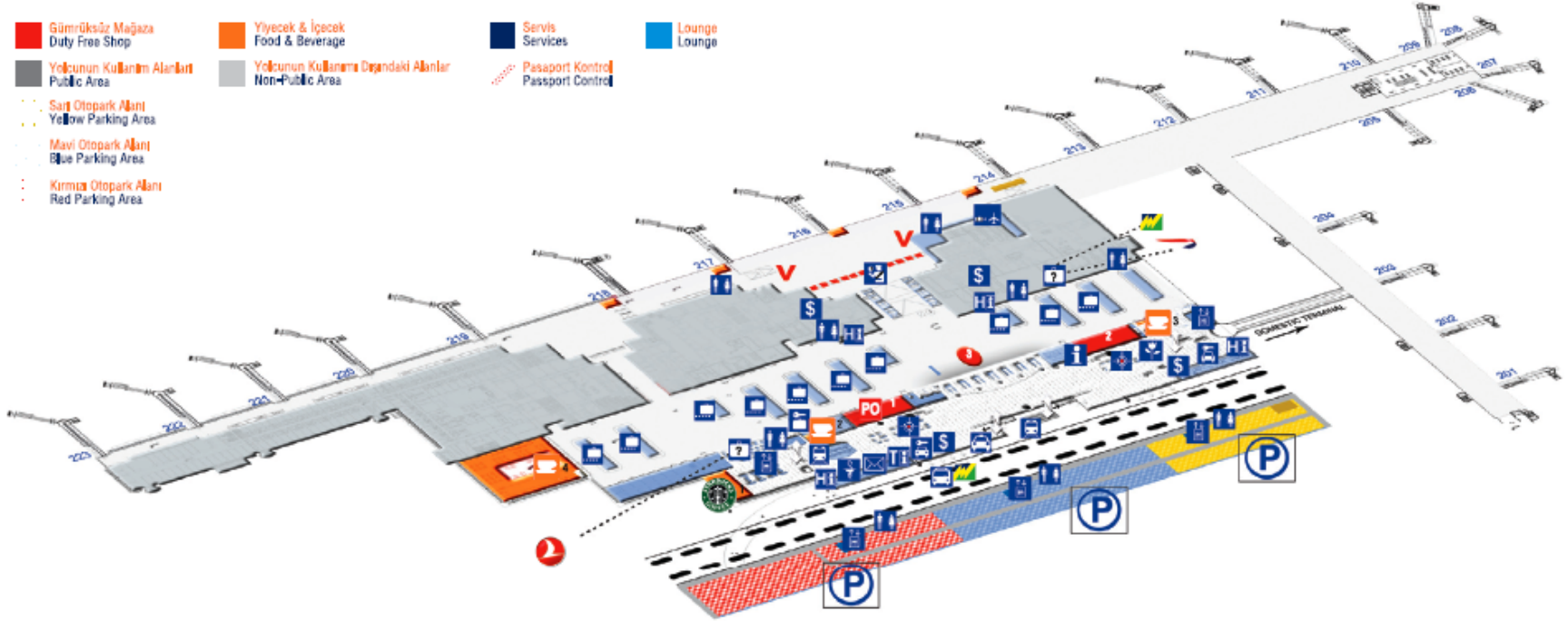

Going to the Movenpick Istanbul Hotel

Some Transportation options:

1. At the exit of Istanbul Ataturk Airport you can find taxis that will bring you to the hotel for about 25-30 Euros. The Istanbul Atatürk Airport is located in Yeşilköy, in the European side of Istanbul. Airports distance is 28 km to the Movenpick Istanbul Hotel. Please note that the taxi rates are 50% higher between 00.00 and 06:00 am.

2. You can take "Havas Bus" for TAKSIM at the exit of Istanbul Ataturk Airport. The fee is 10 Turkish Liras. When you arrive Taksim, you can take a taxi to the hotel or take metro from "Taksim" station to "4. Levent" station. "4. Levent" station is in front of Movenpick Istanbul Hotel.

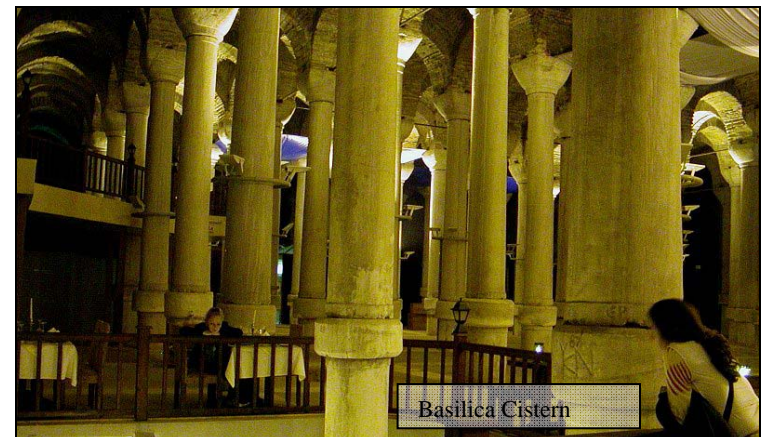
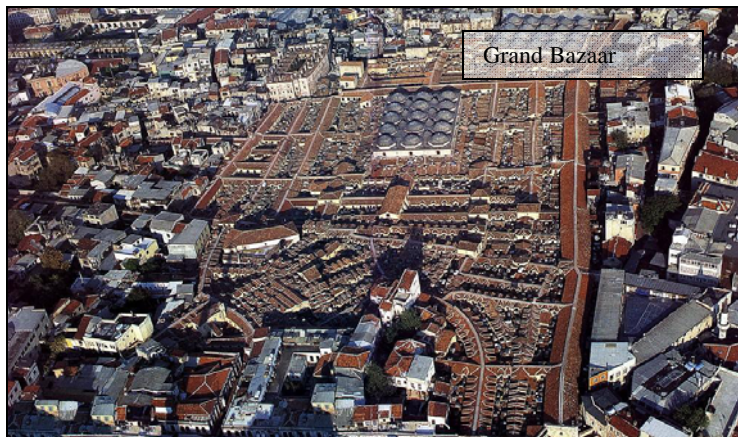
Sightseeing Tour– Sunday, 5th July 2009

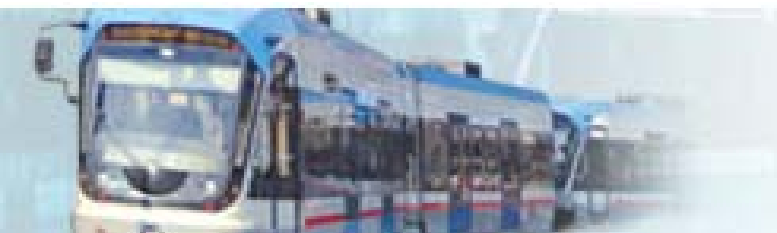
Going to the ITU Campus

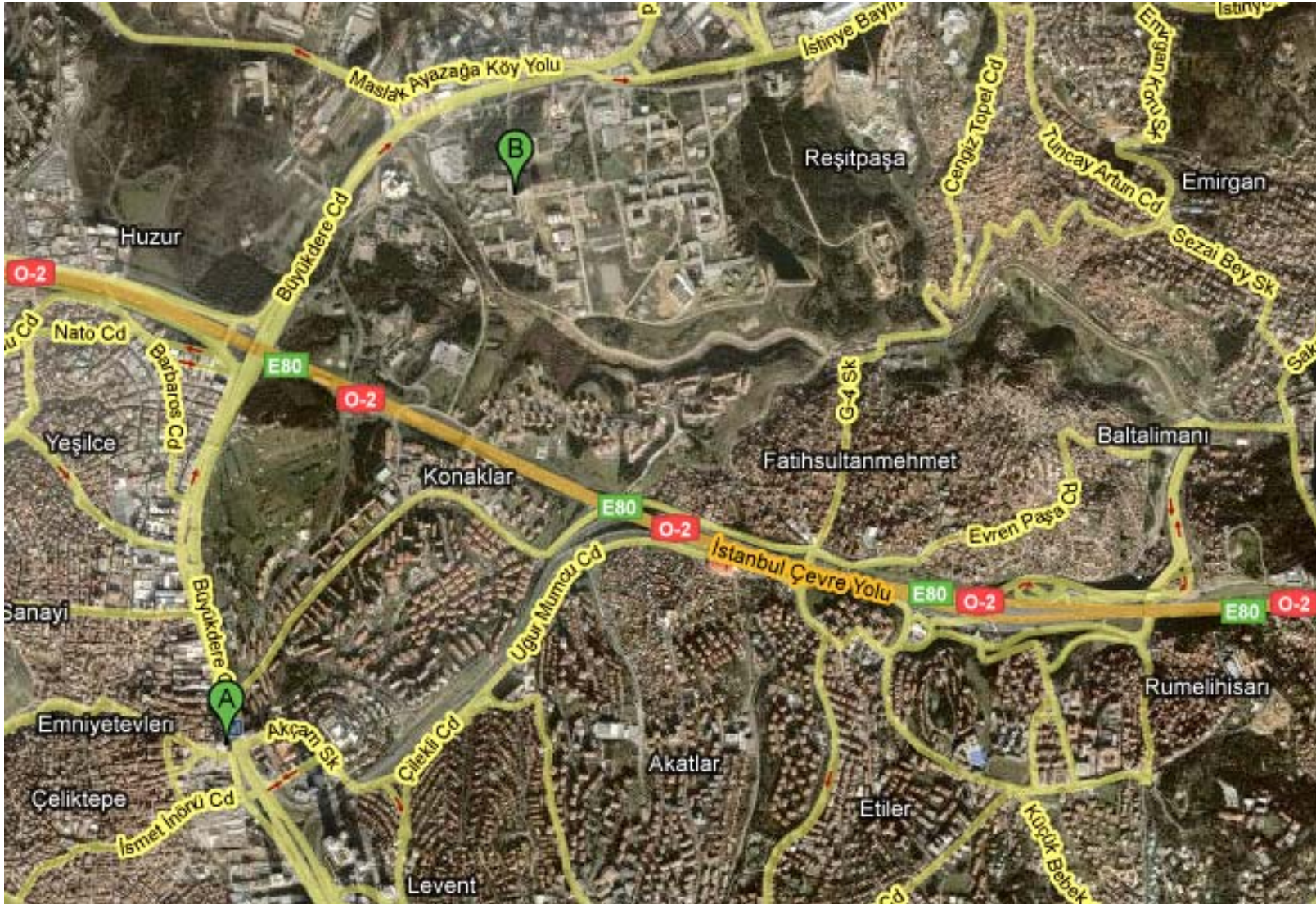

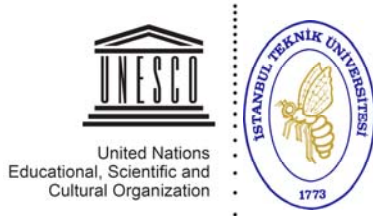

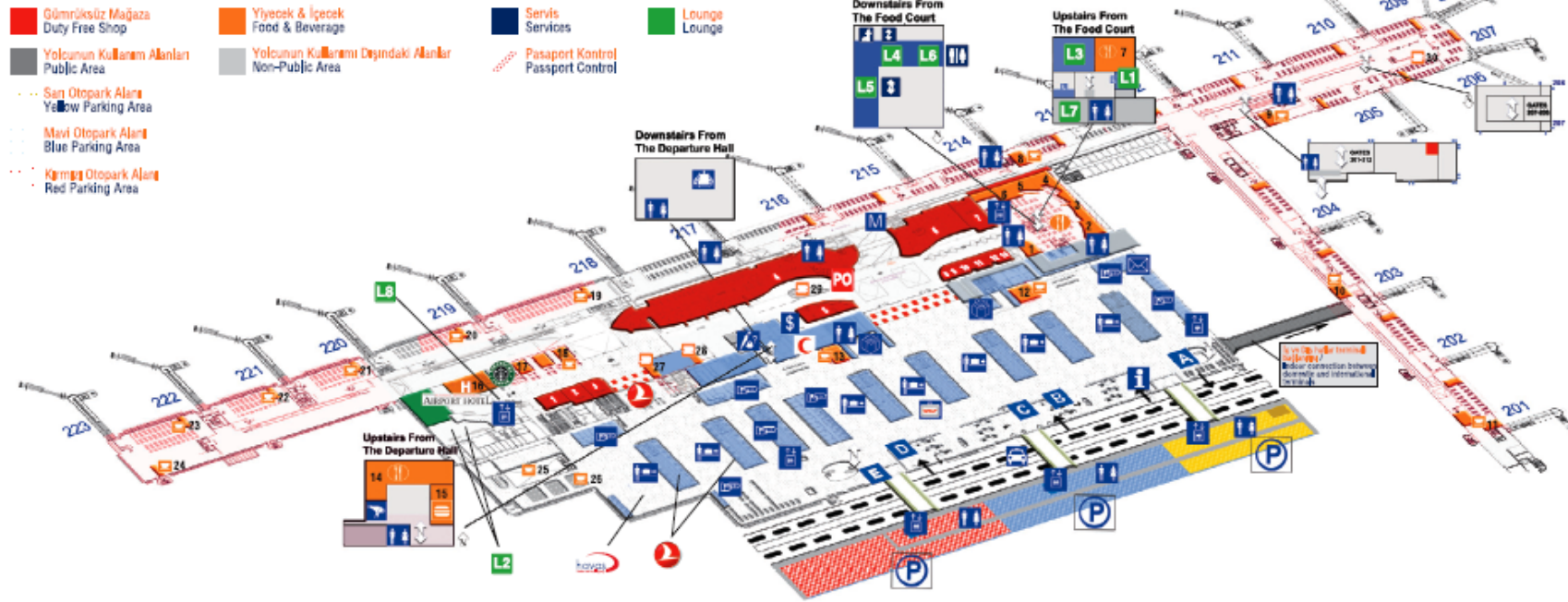
