INVITATIONS TO THE ROUND TABLE OF MINISTERS AND SENIOR OFFICIALS RESPONSIBLE FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORT (Paris, 9 and 10 January 2003)

SUMMARY

In accordance with Article 21 of the "Regulations for the general classification of the various categories of meetings convened by UNESCO" and pursuant to paragraph 12 of the Declaration of Punta del Este (Uruguay), the Director-General submits to the Executive Board the proposals concerning invitations to the Round Table of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport, to be held on 9 and 10 January 2003 at Headquarters, Paris, and suggests that the Board adopt, with regard to these proposals, a decision authorizing the holding of that Round Table.

Decision proposed: paragraph 15.

Introduction

- 1. Paragraph 12 of the Declaration of Punta del Este, arising from the Third International Conference of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport (MINEPS III), provides that "in order to ensure progress, the Ministers recommend to the Director-General of UNESCO the holding of a Round Table of Ministers of Physical Education and Sport at the 31st session of the General Conference of UNESCO with a view to undertaking an interim review of follow-up action to MINEPS III".
- 2. In view of the particularly heavy timetable of the 31st session of the General Conference, the Director-General decided to postpone the Round Table. It is now the subject of this invitation proposal.
- 3. In order to prepare the Round Table more effectively and achieve sound results regarding the objectives set by the Third International Conference of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport (MINEPS III), the Intergovernmental Committee for Physical Education and Sport (CIGEPS) has set up working groups that include leading actors in this field for the purpose of securing their constructive contribution and expertise.

Purpose of the meeting

- 4. In order to make progress in coping with the challenges and issues involved, the Round Table sets out to help achieve objectives concerned with improving the quality of the promotion and development of physical education and sport in those of their aspects which are relevant, in particular, to education and human development.
- 5. The Round Table will be held in cooperation with the Intergovernmental Committee for Physical Education and Sport (CIGEPS), and with the support of its Permanent Consultative Council, on 9 and 10 January 2003 at Headquarters in Paris.

Category of the meeting

6. Under the Regulations for the general classification of the various categories of meetings convened by UNESCO, this Round Table falls within the category of "Intergovernmental meetings other than international conferences of States" (category II) and consequently the chief participants will be representing their governments.

Participants

- 7. In conformity with the provisions of the above-mentioned Regulations applicable to meetings in category II, it is for the Executive Board, on the Director-General's proposal, to decide on the invitations to the Round Table.
 - (a) Member States and Associate Members (Article 21.1 of the Regulations)
- 8. The Director-General proposes that all Member States and Associate Members of UNESCO be invited to take part in the Round Table with the right to vote.

(b) Non-Member States (Article 21.3 of the Regulations)

9. The Director-General proposes that States which are not members of UNESCO but are members of at least one other organization of the United Nations system be invited to send observers to the Round Table. At the time when this document was drafted, the list of such States

was as follows: Brunei Darussalam, Holy See, Liechtenstein and the United States of America. In addition, the Director-General proposes to the Executive Board that those States which become members of any United Nations organization before the opening of the Round Table be invited to attend it as observers.

(c) Palestine

10. In accordance with Article 7B of the Regulations, the Executive Board will invite Palestine to send observers to the Round Table.

(d) International organizations (Article 21.4 and 21.5 of the Regulations)

11. The Director-General reminds the Board that, under Article 21.4 of the Regulations, the organizations of the United Nations system with which UNESCO has concluded mutual representation agreements may send representatives to the Round Table. Those organizations are the following:

15. If the Executive Board approves the proposals made by the Director-General in paragraphs 8 to 14 above, it may wish to adopt the following draft decision:

The Executive Board,

- 1. <u>Recalling</u> that the Third International Conference of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport recommended to the Director-General that he convene the Round Table of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport,
- 2. <u>Having examined</u> the Director-General's proposals concerning invitations to this Round Table.
- 3. <u>Invites</u> the Director-General to convene the Round Table of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport;

4. Decides:

- (a) that invitations to participate, with the right to vote, in the Round Table of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport shall be extended to all Member States and Associate Members of UNESCO;
- (b) that invitations to send observers to the Round Table of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport shall be extended to all States mentioned in paragraph 9 of document 165 EX/7;
- (c) that an invitation to send observers to the Round Table shall be extended to Palestine;
- (d) that invitations to send representatives to the Round Table of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport shall be extended to the organizations of the United Nations system mentioned in paragraph 11 of document 165 EX/7;
- (e) that invitations to send observers to the Round Table of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport shall be extended to the international governmental and non-governmental organizations listed in paragraph 12 of document 165 EX/7;
- (f) that invitations to send observers to the Round Table of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport shall be extended to the institutions and foundations listed in paragraph 13 of document 165 EX/7;
- (g) that invitations to send observers to the Round Table of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport shall be extended to the international organizations mentioned in paragraph 14 of document 165 EX/7;
- 5. <u>Authorizes</u> the Director-General to extend any other invitations that he may deem useful for the work of the Round Table of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport, informing the Executive Board accordingly;
- 6. <u>Urges</u> Member States to take immediate steps, within their fields of competence and in the framework of international cooperation, to cooperate in organizing this Round Table of Ministers and Senior Officials responsible for Physical Education and Sport.
