"A Place for Indigenous People Living in Thailand's Andaman Sea Marine Protected Ares: Surin Islands Marine National Park and Tarutao Marine National Park"

Since 1998, the United Nations Education Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) in partnership with the Social Research Institute, Chulalongkorn University has undertaken field project activities related to issues concerning the place of indigenous people within Thailand's Andaman Sea marine protected areas.

One of the current activities under the project is to conduct field research on socio-economic monitoring (SOCMON) with the Moken people, Surin Islands Marine National Park, Phang-Nga Province, and the Urak Lawoi people, Tarutao Marine National Park, Satun Province. This project phase is carried out with financial support from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) in the USA.
