The ALADIN network supports the **international sharing of adult learning resources, information and expertise** through various projects that are co-ordinated by the Head of Documentation at the UNESCO Institute for Lifelong Learning.

It emerged from a CONFITEA V workshop in 1997 and currently links approximately **100 adult learning documentation and information services in about 50 countries.**

- 200 annotated and organised adult learning links
- constantly updated ALADIN news
- various ALADIN training tools
