From the address of Mr. Anatoly Iksanov, Executive Director of the Intergovernmental Foundation for Educational, Scientific and Cultural Cooperation of the CIS (IFESCCO): «Our mutual goal is the development of art education in the CIS Countries while taking into consideration national and regional characteristics. 
